

Aptima® Auto Detect Kit (Panther® System)

Instructions for Use For *in vitro* diagnostic use Rx only

Intended Use

The Aptima® Auto Detect Kit is an ancillary that facilitates a chemiluminescent reaction that enables the detection of Internal Control (IC) and target amplicon bound to Acridinium Ester (AE) labeled probe oligos. The reaction emits light, which is measured and reported as Relative Light Units (RLUs). The Aptima Auto Detect Kit is used to perform Aptima assays on the Panther® System.

Warnings and Precautions

- A. Avoid contact of Auto Detect 2 with skin, eyes, and mucous membranes. If this fluid comes into contact with skin or eyes, wash with water. If this fluid spills, dilute the spill with water before wiping dry.

- C. Use routine laboratory precautions.

Storage and Handling Requirements

- A. Store the Aptima Auto Detect Kit at 15°C to 30°C.
- B. Fluids must be at 15°C to 30°C before use. Once opened, fluids are stable for 60 days.
- C. If precipitate has formed, heat the fluids at 37°C to 60°C to facilitate dissolution of the precipitate. Cool the fluids to room temperature and thoroughly mix prior to use.
- D. Do not use after the expiration date.
